Empowering students for a brighter future





The presence of our Principal, Vice-Principal, teaching, and non-teaching faculty members. added to the dignity of the occasion.





SPOTLIGHT

Prof. L K Srivatsa's Dedication to BHS HES Institutions:

Prof. L K Srivatsa has dedicated 36 years of his life to serving BHS HES, starting from August 1st, 1990. Throughout his illustrious career, he has held various esteemed positions, which includes serving as a Chemistry Lecturer for 25 years, Head of the Department for 9 years, Vice Principal for 5 years, and Principal for 1 year. His unwavering commitment to the institution and its students is a testament to his passion for education and leadership.



A bird's view of his journey has been captured in this interview

1. How do you recall your long service in this institution?

I look back on my years here with deep gratitude and pride. This institution has not only been my workplace but also a family in which I grew personally and professionally. The journey that shaped me as an educator and administrator.

2. How did your journey from lecturer to principal shape your understanding of the institution and its needs?

Started as a lecturer, which gave me first-hand experience of academic life in the classroom. As I took on responsibilities in working in various committees like Examination, Science, Sports committees, etc., I gained a broader perspective on how the institution functions at multiple levels. This progression taught me that the needs of an institution go beyond academics.

3. What were some of the most significant challenges you faced during your transition from one role to another, and how did you overcome them?

Each transition brought its own challenges—managing colleagues being a senior faculty member, balancing teaching with administrative responsibilities and making difficult decisions that affected students and staff. I overcame these challenges by listening carefully, seeking advice from all the stake holders and making unbiased decisions.

4. How did your experiences in different roles prepare you for your responsibilities as a principal?

Every role equipped me with valuable insights. As a lecturer, I learned the art of teaching. As a head of department, I understood the importance of teamwork and resource management. By the time I became principal, I had already seen the institution from multiple perspectives, which prepared me to make appropriate decisions.

5. What do you believe are the most important contributions you've made to the college during your tenure, and how will they continue to benefit the institution?

Some of the contributions I take the most pride in are following a systematic and disciplined approach in academic programs. I believe these steps have laid a foundation that will continue to help the institution to adapt and grow.

6. How did you foster a sense of community and collaboration among faculty, staff, and students?

I always encouraged collaboration by involving faculty members from various departments to work in academic and co-curricular committees for overall development of students. I believe that everyone's opinion is to be taken into consideration.

7. What changes or innovations did you introduce during your tenure that you believe had the most significant impact?

Making proper presentation of lectures and providing the necessary study materials to the students and making aware of the their responsibilities in life and career in general and academics in particular.

8. How did you balance the needs and expectations of various stakeholders?

Balancing needs constant communication and prioritization. Students often sought support; faculty needed recognition and resources; administrators expected accountability. I approached each of them with transparency and fairness, ensuring that decisions were well explained and in the long-term interest of the institution.

9. Can you describe your approach to fostering a democratic and transparent environment within the institution? I encouraged participatory decision-making by involving faculty members in various committees, sharing plans openly and considering their grievances and suggestions.

10. What were some of the most rewarding experiences you had during your career?

The most fulfilling moments came from seeing students succeed in their careers and alumni share their achievements. Also witnessing faculty and staff grow in their abilities.

11. How do you think your experiences and perspectives will continue to benefit the college after your retirement? After my retirement, I feel that the established systems, values and culture will be continued and nurtured from time to time.

12. How do you envision the college evolving in the future, and what role do you hope it will play in shaping the next generation?

I see the college adopting more technology and practices that are need of the hour, which will enable to improve society's greater acceptability towards the institution. 
